### Herefordshire sustainable modes of travel to school

Herefordshire Council is reviewing its Sustainable Modes of Travel to School Strategy and needs your help in order to better understand how pupils currently travel to and from school and how their journeys could be made more sustainable.

The strategy will help to encourage pupils to travel to and from school in more sustainable ways, where possible, with a vision to "have a fully integrated transport system where every pupil within Herefordshire has the option to travel to and from school through sustainable travel choices, improving health, safety and reducing reliance on short distance car journeys".
