

Science

In Science, we will be finding out all about gravity, air resistance, water resistance and friction and how these can be vital in creating the most exciting rides. We will identify, experiment and measure different forces and discuss how these impact everyday life.

English and basic skills

In English we will continue to practice our basic skills for reading, writing and spelling by completing activities on word classes, punctuation, sentence structure and vocabulary. In Talk for Writing this term we are focusing on a story called 'A Night to Remember' based in a fairground. The children will extend their knowledge, skills and vocabulary and use these to complete their own fairground tale.

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we begin our term by focusing on multiplication, division and fractions. The children will be challenged to work with equivalent fractions, proper/improper fractions and begin to recognise the relationship between these and decimals/percentages. We will continue to practice our times tables daily as these are extremely important for our problem solving and calculations.

Computing

In ICT, we will be using the Ipads to research different fairground rides and who these are aimed at. Using a variety of apps, we will be able to design our own fairground signs and use these ideas to base our art work on. We will continue practicing how to use search engines effectively and responsibly.
